ATTENTION ALL COACHES:

It's time to begin the process of choosing our Div. I and Div. II coaches for the upcoming Fall 2010 Season. For all new coaches, Div I and Div II are competitive levels of play for teams U-11 and older. These levels of play are designed for the more serious and competitive players. These teams usually go to more tournaments and some of them play their season in the Houston area.

If you are interested in applying for a Div I, S2, or Div II coaching position please fill out the enclosed application and return it to your Home Club by April 1, 2010. You may apply at one Club only. Registration fees will be paid to your Home Club. Each local Club will approve their coaches at their respective meetings. Club-recommended coaches will then need to be approved at the Spindletop meeting. ***Having a competitive team for past seasons does not guarantee approval for the 2010-2011 soccer year. Please note that this is for Div. I, Div. II, and Super II coaches ONLY. Recreational coaches will be selected at the Club levels at a later time.***

This year we are implementing a new system for tryouts. All tryouts will be hosted by SYSA at Lamar University. The SYSA board feels that by centralizing tryouts, we will get a better turnout of potential players for you to build a team. You will find the tryout schedule attached to this letter so please make every effort to attend or have a representative attend for you. During the month of May we will be hosting coaches meetings to cement the tryout format. Once accepted by your club, you will receive that meeting information.

When submitting your application for a team, please include a copy of your highest level State Coaching License, along with your coaching experience, plans for your team and any other information you feel is pertinent. You must have at least an "E" State Coaching License by September 1st of the Fall 2010 Season in order to coach a competitive team in the Spindletop Association.

Going through any other procedure, attempting to coerce player commitments to your team, or discouraging players from attending try-outs, may result in an appearance before the Spindletop Discipline & Protest Committee where all your coaching privileges in Spindletop could be revoked.

Each Club's president is listed on the back of this letter for your convenience. Club mailing addresses are listed as well.

NOTE: All paperwork and money is due to your club by July 15, 2010 for at least 11 players(8 for U11/12)---or your team will not be permitted to form. We will be having coaching modules and an "E" state coaching license clinic this summer to insure that all coaches have the opportunity to meet their licensing requirements. If you have not completed your "E" course by September 1st, you will have to give up your team. The team can only be taken over by someone who already has the required "E" state Coaching License. No grace period will be allowed. PLEASE NOTE SPINDLETOP FLOOR RULE: ALL players must wear shinguards during ANY and ALL practices and games. The coach of a player not wearing shinguards will not be allowed to coach for one week.
